1. Principal Andrews discussed the reminder that was sent our through group text message, but only 20% was received. The committee suggested a flier sent home for parents/guardians to update their information.
2. Spirit Night at Chick-Fil-A at City Creek, November 10<sup>th</sup> 5:30-7:30 PM with 20% of sales donated back to Newman. Principal Andrews stated she will send another flier that states people will get free parking.
3. Salt Lake City's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) presented about the SAFE (Schools And Families in Emergencies) Neighborhoods. John Flynt (presenter) discussed the history of the SAFE project, showed a video about the current risk to, and preparation for, an emergency in Salt Lake City. Mr. Flynt shared the contents of his personal 96-hour pack, shared recommendations for a person's own pack and how to get prepared for an emergency. If the community can get 20-30 adults interested, CERT can provide training for one night/week, 3 hours/night for 7 weeks. Training is held every other month and there will be another one in December.
4. School Security/Safety Procedures have been changed. All of the doors to the building will be locked and Pam Haslam (secretary) will monitor the front doors and be able to unlock the front door after verifying the identity of the visitor. Ms. Perez suggested a system of having pre-school teachers walk students to their parents.
5. Principal Andrews suggested having a Town Meeting as a Family Night. She also suggested the Student Lighthouse Team could be the moderators. This may be in conjunction with the January Technology night.
