

May SCC Meeting Minutes

Meeting via Zoom because of COVID-19 regulations.

We discussed the dress code which was approved by Dr. Cunningham. It needs to go out to the community for voting and we discussed how we would proceed with that.

It was suggested an electronic form to be sent out to so people could give their opinions and it can be implemented prior to the end of school.

The Land trust expenditure was discussed. The committee had voted and unanimously agreed to use a portion for an FTE. There is a approximately \$47,000 and change. There maybe \$200 left which can be used for digital citizenship and technology.

Newman was awarded the Digital Teaching and Learning Grant. It will afford a full-time digital teaching and learning coach, professional development for teachers, and technology for our school. Grant goals mirror our school-level goals in terms of student growth: minimum of 4% reading growth and 2% growth/improvement in Social Emotional Learning (SEL) beginning of year to end of year. There are also additional technology implementation goals that span 5 years.

We talked about the future of the SCC for the coming school year and thanked everyone who is on the committee for their service and time they put into it.

We discussed how to get more parents and community members involved for the upcoming school year. Sarah Walker suggested a "mailer" of some sort. Perhaps a little postcard highlighting what SCC is and what it stands for. Roxanne suggested putting it with the online registration documents so parents can see it. A paper hard copy was also talked about to send out to parents.

Manessa, Roxanne and Jason talked about the new teachers. There are several new teachers starting at Newman for the upcoming school year. All of the changes are exciting.

There is a "end of school drive thru" on Tuesday May 25 where students turn in their iPads and school items. It's also a time where we can say goodbye to our teachers.

On Wednesday the 26th, there will be a farewell parade for those teachers who are retiring or transferring to another school.

Rachel and Melissa are going to make a sign to hang up at the school for the teachers.
